

## RESTORATIVE PRACTICES: FACILITATOR SKILLS TRAINING

The objective of the ‘Standard’ Restorative Practices: Facilitator Skills Training, is to prepare participants to facilitate Restorative Practices, including Conferences

This course is relevant to Youth Offending Team and Youth Offender Panel members, Referral Order Co-ordinators, Teachers, Education Welfare Officers, Police, Probation Officers, Youth Workers, Social Workers, Secure Unit and Care Home staff, Victim Service providers, Human Resources staff and others who want to use Restorative approaches in the workplace, schools, justice sector and communities.

Participants receive the books: ‘*REAL JUSTICE*’ by Ted Wachtel and ‘*The Little book of Restorative Justice*’ by Howard Zehr, as course pre-reads.

On the course they will receive a ‘Conferencing Handbook’ with detailed instruction on all aspects of the restorative conference and a ‘Student Course Workbook’.
