### Professional Development Continuing Education Act 48 Credit Instructions for Pennsylvania Educators

Act 48 continuing education credit may be requested by Pennsylvania educators for the following public and private, on-site professional development events conducted by the IIRP:

- **Basic Restorative Practices**  
(24 CE credit hours for all 4 days or 6 CE credit hours for each day)
  - **Introduction to Restorative Practices** (Day 1 of Basic Restorative Practices)
  - **Using Circles Effectively** (Day 2 of Basic Restorative Practices)
  - **Facilitating Restorative Conferences** (Days 3 & 4 of Basic Restorative Practices)  
(Must attend both days to earn credit)
- **Restorative Responses to Adversity and Trauma** (12 CE credit hours)
- **Restorative Leadership Development: Authority with Grace** (12 CE credit hours)
- **Motivational Interviewing** (12 CE credit hours)
- **Aggression Replacement Training®** (12 CE credit hours)

In order to apply for professional continuing education credit for your participation, please follow these steps.

1. Complete the Act 48 sign-in sheet (available at <https://www.iirp.edu/ce-credits>).
2. Also complete the IIRP sign-in sheet on each day of attendance.  
(Or the host's sign-in sheet for private, on-site events.)
3. Have the instructor sign the Act 48 sign-in sheet at the end of the event.  
(Your presence is required during the entire event for the instructor to sign the sheet.)
4. The instructor keeps the sign-in sheet and sends it to the IIRP office. The IIRP will submit your information electronically to the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) within 30 days.
