- Alinsky Model- Power is a zero-sum game Power is taken, never given
- Women-Centered- Power is extremely relational and highly local
- Faith Based Organizing- Relational power is established and leveraged for the greater good

They require excellent listening skills.

They should dig deeply- be curious, don't pry.

They are designed to find out what the person cares about

## **House Meetings**

In peoples homes- because it is more intimate.

You will need a facilitator, a scribe, a host, and SNACKS! (Because food helps people relax)

No more than 8 people including the three above.

Take no more than 2.5 hours.

Begin by providing an example-TELL A STORY!

House meetings are about sharing what we care about and identifying issues **not about fixing or solving problems.**
