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Writing Wrongs: The Programme

- The **Writing Wrongs** programme is a new framework, to be used by organisations that support young people
- **Writing Wrongs** facilitates the delivery of restorative practices and restorative justice in Secondary Schools, Youth Offending Teams, the Secure Estate and the Young People's Service
- **Writing Wrongs** is most effective when delivered through organisations that also have taken part in wider training opportunities for restorative justice or restorative practice. We are opening dialogue with training organisations in the UK and further afield to see how the **Writing Wrongs** programme can effectively support on-going initiatives and strategies

Writing Wrongs

- Two separate programmes for Secondary Schools and the Youth Justice System
- Secondary Schools – 6 point programme
- Youth Justice System – 5 point programme

A Sporting Theme

- With sporting events, there are opposing sides
- There are winners and losers
- After the event, there is much deliberation
- **Writing Wrongs** takes these themes and transfers them to the wrongdoers and wronged parties in a conflict
- **Writing Wrongs** provides opportunities for all young people to gain a thorough and comprehensive understanding of the restorative processes leading to socially inclusive outcomes, where all those involved are winners



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
