
Citizens are uniquely able to in their own situation and together with other directly affected, discuss what is going on, aimed at making a plan for a solution.


Independent organisation

- Implementing FGC in NL since 2000
- Over 10.000 FGC's
- Over 60 research studies in NL
- Two FGC amendments passed in Parliament

Inspiration from New Zealand

- Family group is context;
- Especially for decision & resolution;
- Widen the circle;
- Government may set condition(s) for plan;
- Family group in the lead, has private time;
- Professionals accept and support safe plan and deliver services asked for;
- FGC is primary decision making;
- FGC citizens right; legal mandate (CYPFA 1989);
- Responsibility stays with Family Group



Purposes of FGC



- Decision-making and case planning
- Enabling discourse between two sets of legitimate interests
- Mitigating power imbalances
- Making consensus-based plans
- Ensuring that plans are effected



FGC / EK-c challenges professional processes that...

- ...take over responsibilities that rightly belong with citizens,
- ...exclude wider family group involvement in decision making,
- ...define service eligibility and need without reference to family groups;

Different kinds of conferences

- Eigen-kracht conferentie (FGC)
 Dealing with problems within a family or living unit
- Restorative conference
 Dealing with conflicts between parties or at school etc.
- Community conference
 Dealing with difficult situations in a neighbourhood or organisation by having those involved work together to a solution
- EK-c for learning questions
 At schools for promoting the individual school careers of pupils



- The form of conference model that fits best will be chosen
- Principles are the same:
 - Decision-making process
 - Responsability with the citizens
 - Widening the circle
 - Independent coordinator





Conferencing:

- Leaving responsibility with citizens or returning it to citizens
- Widening the circle
- Making their restorative plan
- Restoring together
- Including family, social network, 'peergroup', everybody involved
- Directorship/control in the hands of citizens














Family Group Conference





Independence is key

- Control and direction with citizens
 - Independent FGC coordinators
 - lay people, 2x3 days training, community coord (83 languages)
 - Independent FGC organisation
 - EKC staff responsible for coaching coordinators
- Independence meaning:
 - No interest in the outcome of the plan
 - No influence on the contents of the plan



Community coordinator

- Recruited from families/community
- Different professions
- Different ethnicities (99 languages)
- Cultural respectful to families
- Preparation can start today
- Impact in communities
- Access to different networks for implementation and recruitment

NL: Outcomes...trends

- On the average 13 participants
- Plans after conference started:
 - 15 % informal plans
 - 14 % no plan
 - 71 % formal conference plan
- No unsafe agreements
- Satisfaction Conference-Plan-Coordinator:
 - Young people
 7.7 8.5 8.4
 - Families 7.7 7.8 8.0
 - Professionals7.7 7.4 8.0



Discovery of FGC

- It is not about problems or conflicts or about people who can or cannot..
- It is all about how the circle can be widened and addressed with regards to their joint capacity to use their common 'social capital' and as first, come up with a plan.
- It is about a right for citizens to make a plan first



FGC is widening the circle
